ANNOUNCEMENT

The Center of Studies in Educational Sciences from Sancti Spíritus "Raúl Ferrer Pérez" (CECESS), from the University of Sancti Spíritus "José Martí Pérez" (UNISS) and the Education Studies Network (REED), convene the VI CECESS International Scientific Convention, to be held, by hybrid modality (in-person and online), between October 15 and 17, 2024, in Trinidad, Creative City and World Heritage Site.

The convention will focused its work on the **VI International Scientific Workshop** "University Convergence in Educational Sciences", which central themes are organized into three commissions and two colloquiums:

Commission 1: Academic networks to build integrational spaces

GENERAL SCIENTIFIC PROGRAM

It includes opening cultural activities, masterly lectures, interactive debates, pre-event courses and visits to places of interest and historical-cultural interest in the Trinitarian town.

In-person speakers

They are the delegates who make their presentation directly in the established face-to-face rooms, promoting debate about their contribution.

The registration fee for in-person delegates includes: accreditation module, academic program and information about the event, participant diploma and work presentation diploma, attendance at academic activities, specialized visits, official opening and closing activities, cultural gala and farewell activity.

Student

They are the delegates (in person or online) who are pursuing undergraduate university studies who are accepted as duly legalized speakers and/or participants. The registration fee includes the same benefits defined for the rest of the speakers and/or participants.

Online speakers

They are the delegates who participate virtually with two variants: synchronous (with presentations and a video of up to three minutes with a discussion of their contributions) and asynchronous (with a virtual poster that is discussed through open forums within the framework of the event).

The registration fee for online delegates includes the academic program, the participation diploma (includes the title of the presentation), and the possibility of being present, synchronously, in the academic and official activities (opening and closing).

In-person and online participant

They are the delegates who do not present papers, but due to their condition they have the right to participate in all activities according to their modality (in person or online), therefore, it is not reflected in the scientific program and they are only awarded the diploma of participants.

The registration fee includes the same benefits as the speakers.

Guest

They are the delegates who, due to their relevance and contribution to the development of the event, are invited to participate by the Organizing and Scientific Committee of the event (in person or online) with a mission defined in the invitation and their condition includes the same benefits as the speakers.

REQUIREMENTS FOR THE PRESENTATION OF PAPERS

A presentation will be sent structured as follows:

Written in letter size paper, 12 point Arial font and one and a half space spacing. The minimum length is 15 pages, and a maximum of 25, including graphs, tables, diagrams, etc.

The title must be presented in Spanish and English, in sustained capital letters, and will not exceed 15 words.

The presentation will be headed by the title, authors (names and two surnames, teaching rank, scientific degree and academic titles, ORCID registration number, center of origin, country and e-mail). Up to 3 authors will be accepted for each work.

Each paper must be presented accompanied by an abstract in Spanish and the English translation (Abstract) with no more than 200 words; as well as the keywords and their corresponding translation into English (Keywords).

Quotations, sources and bibliographic references must respond to APA format (7th edition). 50% of them must be of the last 5 years.

Works derived from scientific research must have to the following structure:

- Title

- Abstract
- Keywords
- Introduction
- Material and method
- Results
- Discussion
- Conclusions
- Bibliographic references.

The presentations that are accepted due to their quality will form part of an electronic book.

The summaries of the presentations will be sent to the emails that appear in each commission or colloquium.

To participate in the VI International Scientific Conference of CECESS, the authors of the selected works must pay the following fee, as appropriate:
